

Supplemental Issue for July 2021

In past years, we have had a single issue of the Bulletin for June/July. This year, with the frequent changes in restrictions and opening up, there was a single issue for June, and we're bringing you this abbreviated Supplemental Issue for July.

Our Congregational Engagement Committee has been meeting regularly to evaluate and make recommendations to the board regarding the steps required to re-open the synagogue to normal operations. Currently, our Shabbat morning services are open for anyone to attend and we are serving Kiddush lunch following. Consistent with CDC guidelines, children and adults who are not vaccinated should continue to wear masks. Masks are optional for those fully vaccinated. Attendees may take personal responsibility to sit and distance themselves from others as they feel comfortable.

Funerals are currently taking place graveside. We are in the process of determining other cemetery guidelines with regard to shiva and the use of our cemetery chapel.

We anticipate being fully open for the high holidays, providing an area for those who need or would prefer to have more space for seating. The committee is evaluating all issues surrounding the holidays and services and, along with Rabbi Crespy and Cantor Raizen, will determine any tweaks in the services and assignment of honors. All services will continue to be streamed. At this time, daily evening minyan and Kabbalat Shabbat services will continue virtually via zoom.

Additionally, we are allowing meetings to take place in the building with the hope of providing those who are not yet ready to attend in person, an option to attend virtually.

We appreciate everyone's understanding, support and patience as we work through all of the logistics. We have a fabulous committee who is working tirelessly to bring us back to our "new normal" as we ensure that our members feel comfortable and safe. A quick survey of congregants in the Dayton area showed that our congregation may well be over 95% vaccinated.

We are enjoying the ability to see each other again in person!

TISHA B'AV Saturday, July 17 9:45 pm

Tisha B'Av, the fast day that commemorates the destruction of both the First and Second Temples in Jerusalem, takes place this year from the evening of **Saturday, July 17** through sundown on Sunday. Because Shabbat ends late that Saturday night, we will have our service on Zoom, beginning with Havdalah at **9:45 PM**. We will then have the evening service that will include the chanting of *Eicha*, the Book of Lamentations, and some brief virtual tours of the Old City of Jerusalem. 
